Extract of a Letter from Commodore Affleck to Mr. Stephens, dated at New York, August 13, IN Pursuance of the Directions of an Act passed 1781. SIR, HAVE the Pleafure to inform their Lordihips of the Arrival of His Majelty's Ship Iris, from her Station off the Delaware, with the Trumbull Rebel Frigate of 32 Guas and 200 Men; taken by her on the 9th Infant, after a running Fight of about an Hour, in which the Iris had i Man killed and 6

wounded; and the Enemy had 2 killed, and 3 Wohnded; and the Energy had 2 kinds, and 3 Lieutenants, and 7 Men, wounded. While I am writing is' this Inflant arrived the Bellifarius, a very falt-failing Frigate of 20 Guns and 147 Men, belonging to Saleni, captured by the Medea on the 7th Instant, off the Delaware.
